



ATTENTION UFCW LOCAL 7 JBS MEMBERS

We have been advised that the JBS plant will partially re-open tomorrow, Friday, April 24th at 6 a.m. for the Kill Division. The Fabrication Division will re-open on Monday, April 27th. As you know, JBS recently advised you via text message that if you are *sick*, or exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms, you should stay home and *not report to work*. Please call and report to HR at 970-304-7215 if you are not going to report to work.

The Union continues to demand that every worker receives COVID-19 testing. The Company may be testing workers who have a temperature or COVID-19 like symptoms, however neither the company nor the public health authorities have agreed to test workers who are asymptomatic (may be infected with the Coronavirus, but may not show symptoms).

Please be advised that there will be Community COVID-19 testing at Island Grove Regional Park starting at 10 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday and Sunday, and we encourage all workers to be tested.

If you experience any symptoms while at work, please make sure to report your circumstances to plant management and your Union Representative immediately.

We will be back to service you in the plant as soon as Governor Jared Polis lifts the Shelter In Order for our office. We are still working remotely and we are here to help you. Please give us a call if you need further assistance.
