

WELD COUNTY COMMUNITY TESTING

The State's COVID-19 Unified Command Center (UCC) will be standing up a community testing site in Weld County to promote community-wide COVID-19 testing from Friday, April 24 - Tuesday, April 28. The testing, coordinated by the State Emergency Operations Center and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, is being staffed by members of the Colorado National Guard with support from the Colorado State Patrol.

WHEN:

Friday, April 24 - Tuesday, April 28
10 a.m. - Approx. 3 p.m.

LOCATION:

Island Grove Parking Lot
501 N 14th Ave., Greeley, CO 80631
(East Side Gates)

We encourage people who are eligible to get tested (individuals with symptoms) to do it as soon as possible, preferably Friday.

WHO WILL BE TESTED:

Testing is open to any Weld County resident with symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, coughing, shortness of breath). Asymptomatic individuals will not be tested.

TESTING IS FREE.

The state is welcoming people who may have been in close contact with employees at Greeley's JBS Swift plant-- this includes Weld County residents who are family members, roommates, and coworkers.

HOW WILL TESTING BE COMPLETED:

The majority of tests will be administered through a drive up test. There will be a walk thru lane for individuals not in a vehicle.

No appointment or proof of insurance, identification, or citizenship is necessary. An ID is not required, but is recommended for patient intake forms. The form will include basic information to help identify test samples.
