



The Family Medicine peer review committee is looking for a **nurse practitioner** to be on the team.

The committee seeks people who practice evidence-based medicine, have the ability to objectively review their peers and have a passion for excellence in Family Medicine.

The committee meets monthly, on the first Wednesday from 8-12. The majority of the time, the committee does not need the full 4 hours, but this allows the group to have the time to richly discuss cases in detail. This time is billed to administration.

A person may have 0-2 cases to review in a month, which can take a few minutes to an hour depending on the complexity of the review. The review takes place during time before and after committee meetings, but is paid time.

Due to Covid, the committee is meeting virtually through teams.
