



For the first time, CPMG is excited to invite local 7 APPs to CITE symposiums as partners of the healthcare team.

What is CITE symposium?

This is a high-yield, comprehensive, 3-day symposium that covers nearly all technical tools available to CPMG physicians and Local 7 APPs within Health Connect to improve efficiencies. CITE is designed, developed, and led by CPMG physicians with ample time for building and practice. This event is held off-site to allow focused attention and minimize any clinical distractions.

CPMG will be reserving a total 5 spaces for APPs at each CITE symposium (for a combination of APPs from Specialty and PC).

This year, there will be two in-person and one virtual symposium.

APPs that want to attend will need to use their CME or vacation time

The in-person CME is 2.5 days and comes with 24 hours of CME credits.
The virtual CME is 3 full days and comes with 20 hours of CME credits.

CITE coordinators will assist with getting APPs laptops and home access to all necessary logins and PingID's for doing the virtual sessions from their homes.

CPMG has generously agreed to pay for the APPs attending CITE.

For in-person (which will be at Beaver Run this year), CPMG will cover lodging and food for the APP only. There will be an option for the APP to pay for their significant other to eat at the food buffet with the CITE attendees.

As APPs, we will be held to the same rules around how often one can attend CITE, which is that you cannot have attended CITE in the last three years.

Dates for 2023:

In-person: April 25th- April 29th and Oct 22nd- Oct 25th
Virtual: September 12th- September 14th

APPs must request time off for this through the normal bidding process, and approvals will follow the current contract and vacation bidding process, according to the contract and meeting operational department staffing requirements.
