Below are key points to know regarding nominations:

Who is eligible to be nominated?

- LPNs
- RNs
- APNs
- Both represented and non-represented staff included

How can I nominate someone?

- In person at local MOBs
- From QR Codes on posters at each MOB

Who can submit nominations?

- Nurses may be nominated by anyone – visitors, patients, families, and colleagues.

How often are nominations reviewed?

- Nominations are collected and reviewed quarterly (January, April, July, October) on the 3rd Friday of the month.

What are the due dates for each review period?

- Nominations are due 15 days before the formal committee review dates
 - April 2021: Nominations due 4/1/2021 - Our first review meeting, and we would love to have as many nominations to choose candidates from at that meeting!
 - July 2021: Nominations due 7/1/2021
 - October 2021: Nominations due 9/30/2021
- All submissions received after the above due dates will be held until the next selection meeting and reviewed at that time.
